



Fourth Grade Team Supply List for 2009-2010

- **Notebook:** Standard, durable, quality three-ring binder, 1 ½ inches wide. No zippers or trapper style
- **2 Composition Book:** Wide Ruled (70-120 sheets)
- **Three Durable Folders:** Pockets at the bottom
- **Pencil Box:** Standard size
- **Pencils:** Five dozen, sharpened
- **Pencil Sharpener:** One that catches shavings and has a secure lid
- **Ruler:** Marked in Standard and Metric Measurements
- **Calculator:** Basic functions with fairly large keys
- **Erasers:** One large white plastic or vinyl (e.g. Magic Rub) preferable, or Pink Pearl type.
- **Scissors:** Pointed, standard size scissors
- **Glue:** One bottle white Elmer's glue and one package (at least 6) white glue sticks- no purple glue sticks
- **Flair Pens** by Paper Mate: One package of any color(s) (at least three pens)
- **Colored Pencils:** Crayola (24 Pack)
- **Sharpies:** Two black **fine tip** and two **ultra fine tip** markers
- **Sharpies:** One set of 12 colored, fine tip
- **Highlighters:** Three, any colors
- **1 Package Notebook Paper:** Wide ruled
