

# 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Supply List

- **No. 2 Pencils:** Ample supply
  - **1 Large Eraser**
  - **2 Ball Point Pens:** Blue and/or black
  - **2 Highlighter Pens:** Any color
  - **1 Calculator:** A basic model with fairly large keys.
  - **10 Solid-Colored Two-Pocket Folders in at least 5 colors.** \*Durable!
  - **2 Composition Books:** sturdy cardboard, marble cover only
  - **1 Supply Box:** 5 x 7" \*Durable!
  - **1 Small Hand-Held Pencil Sharpener**
  - **1 Pair Scissors:** Standard type adult size.
  - **2 Large Glue Sticks**
  - **Post-It Notes:** 3 standard 3x3" pads, and 3 mini - 1 ½ x 2 " size pads
  - **Felt Tip Markers:** One small set of 8-10.
  - **Colored Pencils:** One set of 8-12.
  - **2 Black Flair Pens:** Used for art projects
  - **1 Black Sharpie Pen**
  - **Crayons:** Maximum size, box of 24
