*Ninth graders residing in the RHS attendance area may compete in these sports. All 9th graders must process their eligibility forms at Redmond High School, but purchase their ASB card at their junior high school.

ATHLETIC ELIGIBILITY PROCESS

All student athletes must complete the athletic eligibility process for each sport and for each season they participate.

1. Academic Eligibility

- Is based upon a student's GPA from the previous semester. Athletes must be currently enrolled in at least (4) four full-time subjects.
- Athletes must have passed all classes with a 2.0 GPA from the previous semester. A student who does not make the initial grade requirement will be placed on academic probation. As soon as the student is passing all classes and has a 2.0 GPA, they may then be reinstated for competition by the athletic director.

2. School Fines

- Athletes must pay all school fines and return all equipment/uniforms from previous sports teams.

3. ASB Card and Sports Participation Fee

- Athletes must submit proof of payment of **ASB fee of \$40. Sports Participation fee of \$275 is due when athlete makes the team and before the first contest.**

4. Eligibility Forms – both sides of all five forms must be completed

- Gold Physical Examination Card for Interscholastic Athletics / Emergency Card
Physical exams are good for 2 years.
- Purple Kingco Athletic Eligibility
- Yellow Drug, Alcohol and Tobacco Year Round Code
- Green Health Insurance Portability & Accountability Act – Athletic Trainer Consent
- White Sport Specific Safety Rules

5. Clearance Cards

- A clearance card will be issued to the student athlete after all the above requirements are met. Student athletes must present the clearance card to their coach on the first day of tryouts.
- **Without a current clearance card, athletes will not be allowed to participate.**

Sports Participation Fee Refunds are issued through the Athletics Department under the following conditions:

Student is cut from the squad by the coach

Student quits due to illness, injury or family moving prior to the 1st contest

Fee refund must be requested by November 30, 2009.
